Lillian Jacobey Baur Early Childhood Award Call for Proposals

Departments and programs are invited to submit one proposal for a doctoral Graduate Research Assistantship (GRA) position funded by the Lillian Jacobey Baur Early Childhood Endowment. This fund supports research in early childhood education, socialization, and therapy. A successful proposal will receive up to two years of doctoral GRA support. The GRA must partner with a faculty mentor(s) whose research seeks to generate new knowledge of the physical, social and/or cognitive development of children, pre-natal to up to 6 years old.

The funds support salary and fringe for a 9-month appointment, plus tuition for up to 15 credit hours per year (which may include summer coursework). Each year the GRA may request up to \$1,500 for research support activities. Examples of research support may include data collection expenses, purchasing materials and equipment in support of the research project, traveling to meetings and other universities, or to support seminars and workshops for practitioners.

CRITERIA FOR FUNDING

The fundamental criterion for funding is the support of a doctoral Graduate Research Assistant for research concerned with early childhood education, socialization and/or therapy.

The proposal should address the following:

- 1. The dissertation proposal Clearly describe the proposed project, the significance of the research, the methods and feasibility, its alignment with university priorities, and its impact on issues of early childhood education, socialization and/or therapy.
- 2. Impact for the student Explain how the GRA will enhance the graduate student's doctoral education and ensure timely completion of the degree.
- 3. Monitoring Describe how the department will mentor and track the progress of the doctoral student.
- 4. Budget Provide a budget, including the salary and fringe (not to exceed \$18,000) for a <u>typical</u> GRA in your department or program.

ELIGIBILITY

Proposals for this doctoral GRA funding will be accepted from departments and programs within the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences and the School of Education. The recipient must be interested in pursuing research and associated activities concerned with early childhood education, socialization and/or therapy. The student's dissertation proposal does not have to be officially approved at the point of nomination, as this award is intended to provide the opportunity to develop and finish the dissertation in a timely manner.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Proposals (no longer than 5 pages) will be considered by the Baur Early Childhood Committee, whose members are appointed by the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences and will include a member appointed by the Dean of the School of Education. Funding decisions will be made soon after the deadline.

Each proposal should be accompanied by 1) a copy of the student's Curriculum Vitae, and 2) an endorsement from the faculty mentor and chair/director.*
